2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 8 MRSA §1031-A is enacted to read:**

6 **§1031-A. Daily loss limit**

8 A slot machine operator shall establish a daily loss limit  
10 of \$300 per person per 24-hour period. The operator shall  
12 install devices in slot machines and employ other monitoring  
14 methods to monitor each player's wagering on slot machines in  
16 order to comply with this section.

18 **Sec. 2. 17 MRSA §341, sub-§5-A is enacted to read:**

20 **5-A. Daily loss limit.** A person authorized to operate slot  
22 machines or other mechanical devices used for playing games of  
24 chance under this chapter or Title 8, chapter 31 shall establish  
a daily loss limit of \$300 per person per 24-hour period.

**SUMMARY**

This bill establishes a daily loss limit of \$300 per person per 24-hour period for slot machines and other mechanical devices used for playing games of chance operated in this State.
