SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 446, L.D. 1266, Bill, "An Act To Ensure Integrity in the Voting Process"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the 3rd line from the end (page 2, line 33 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and free of charge"

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in subsection 2 in the last line (page 2, line 35 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "753-B" the following: 'subject to the fees set forth in subsection 4'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the list created by a municipal clerk or registrar of persons who requested or were furnished absentee ballots must be made available to any person who requests the list upon payment of the fees set forth in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 21-A, section 196, subsection 4.
