Further amend the bill in section 5 in subsection 10 in the 6 4th line (page 4, line 1 in L.D.) by striking the following: ', automobile recycling business'

#### **SUMMARY**

12 The amendment keeps the automobile hobbyist exemption in the laws governing automobile graveyards and amends the exemption to 14 provide that municipal ordinances may require areas that are used for hobbyist activities to comply with screening requirements and 16 certain environmental standards. The amendment also strikes a reference to automobile recycling businesses in the operating 18 standards for junkyards and automobile graveyards.
