Amend the amendment by striking out all of section 4 and inserting in its place the following:


'Sec. 4. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1, 2006.'

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment strikes the General Fund appropriation for debt service costs in fiscal years 2005-06 and 2006-07 associated with the proposed borrowing and delays the issuance of securities until 7/1/2006. The Judicial Department will absorb the first year debt service costs of approximately \$27,500 in fiscal year 2006-07 utilizing existing budgeted resources .
