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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 870, L.D. 1273, Bill, "An Act To Improve Economic Development of the Penobscot Nation"

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Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

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'An Act To Improve the Economic Development of the Indian Tribes'

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Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

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'Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §5250-J, sub-§1, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 688, Pt. D, §2, is amended to read:

1. Creation. One or more units of local government, or an organization representing one or more units of local government, or the Aroostook Band of Micmacs, the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians, the Penobscot Nation or the Passamaquoddy Tribe, may apply to the commissioner for the designation of a Pine Tree Development Zone within the boundaries of the unit or units of local government in accordance with the requirements of this governments may apply on behalf subchapter. County unorganized territories. Groups of units of local government may multijurisdictional or for joint projects. Multijurisdictional applications require designation of one unit of local government as the lead applicant and consent for that designation by each participating unit of local government. 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B. The Androscoggin Valley region, including the Lewiston Enterprise Community Zone as designated by the federal Agriculture, Rural Development, Food and Drug Administration, and Related Agencies, Appropriations Act, Public Law 105-277 (1999);

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C. The Penobscot Valley region, --including-up-te--500-aeres ef-land-reserved-fer-the-Penebscot-Nation; and

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D. Washington County and the Downeast region, -including -up to -500 - acres -of -land -reserved -for -the -Passamaquoddy -Tribe -: and

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E. Up to 100 acres of land owned by the Aroostook Band of Micmacs and the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians; up to 500 acres of land owned by the Penobscot Nation; and up to 500 acres of land owned by the Passamaguoddy Tribe.

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Ne Notwithstanding the property designated in paragraph E, no more than one zone may be established in each of the areas specified in paragraphs A to D, except that the commissioner may designate up to 4 additional zones through the process established in section 5250-L.'

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34 SUMMARY

This amendment removes the current tribal property from the Pine Tree Development Zone 5,000-acre limit and allows the tribes to designate any part of their land, up to the statutory 500 acres, or 100 acres for the Aroostook Band of Micmacs and the Houlton Band of Maliseet Indians, as Pine Tree Development Zones.

This bill may reduce General Fund revenue as a result of expanding the amount of land eligible for Pine Tree Development Zone benefits. The exact amount by fiscal year can not be estimated at this time. The additional costs to the Department of Economic and Community Development can be absorbed utilizing existing budgeted resources.
