COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 874, L.D. 1277, Bill, "An Act Regarding Speech-language Pathology Aides"

Amend the bill in section 1 in the 5th line (page 1, line 31 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "to delay" the following: 'until December 31, 2008'

Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of the 2nd sentence (page 1, lines 33 to 35 in L.D.)

SUMMARY

This amendment specifies the exact date, instead of a range of years, by which speech-language pathology aides have to meet the requirements for registration as speech-language pathology assistants.
