20 COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 880, L.D. 1283, Bill, "An  
22 Act To Allow Applicants for Limited Radiographer Licenses To Take  
Qualifying Views"

24 Amend the bill by striking out everything after the title  
and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

26 'Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not  
28 become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted  
as emergencies; and

30 Whereas, it must be ensured that applicants for limited  
32 radiographer licenses have the ability to take the qualifying  
views necessary to obtain their licenses and aid in the delivery  
of health care in the State; and

34 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts  
36 create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of  
38 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately  
necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and  
40 safety; now, therefore,

42 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

44 **Sec. 1. 32 MRSA §9854, sub-§3, ¶C, as enacted by PL 1983, c.**  
524, is amended to read:

46 C. A resident physician or a student enrolled in and  
48 attending a school or college of medicine, osteopathy,  
chiropractic, podiatry, dentistry or radiologic technology  
50 or an individual who is concurrently obtaining the education  
and clinical training required by the board by rule who

2 applies ionizing radiation to a human being while under the  
supervision of a licensed practitioner; or

4 **Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the  
preamble, this Act takes effect when approved.'

**SUMMARY**

This amendment replaces the bill. It provides that  
12 individuals concurrently obtaining the education and clinical  
training required by the Radiologic Technology Board of Examiners  
14 by rule may take qualifying views for the purpose of obtaining a  
limited radiographer license. This amendment adds an emergency  
preamble and emergency clause to the bill.
