2 **Sec. 1. Mobile home titling system. Resolved:** That the Secretary
of State shall develop a titling system for new mobile homes. In
4 developing the system, the Secretary of State shall review the
Final Report of the Study Group on the Title of Certain Personal
6 Property, dated January 15, 2004. In conducting its review, the
Secretary of State may invite the participation of interested
8 stakeholders, including, but not limited to, the Manufactured
Housing Association of Maine; the Maine Credit Union League; the
10 Maine Bankers Association; and the Maine Association of Community
Banks; and be it further

12 **Sec. 2. Submission of proposal. Resolved:** That the Department of
the Secretary of State shall submit a proposal related to the
14 system developed pursuant to section 1, along with any necessary
implementing legislation, for presentation to the Second Regular
16 Session of the 122nd Legislature. The department is authorized
to introduce a bill related to its proposal to the Second Regular
18 Session of the 122nd Legislature at the time of submission of its
proposal.
