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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "#" to H.P. 887, L.D. 1290, Bill, "An Act To Improve Funding for Telecommunications Relay Services"

Amend the bill by inserting after the enacting clause and before section 1 the following:

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'Sec. 1. 35-A MRSA §7104, sub-§5, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 553, Pt. A, §4, is amended to read:

5. Funds for Communication Equipment Fund. The commission shall annually transfer \$85,000 from a state universal service fund established pursuant to this section to the Communications Equipment Fund established under Title 26, section 1419-A. In addition-to-its-authority-under-subsection-3,-the-commission-may require-contributions to-the-state-universal-service-fund-in-an amount-sufficient-to-cellect-the-\$85,000.

If the Department of Labor, Bureau of Rehabilitation Services does not receive from federal or other sources funds in addition to the \$85,000 sufficient to carry out the purposes of Title 26, section 1419-A, the commission, at the request of the Department of Labor, Bureau of Rehabilitation Services, may transfer from the state universal service fund to the Communications Equipment Fund an additional amounts-as-long-as+ \$37,500.
