COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 453, L.D. 1326, "Resolve, Directing the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System To Institute a Statewide Sports Program"

Amend the resolve in section 1 in the last line (page 1, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "program." and inserting in its place the following: 'program; and be it further'

Further amend the resolve by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. Report. Resolved: That, no later than January 2, 2006, the Board of Trustees of the University of Maine System shall submit a report to the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs containing a description of actions taken pursuant to section 1 to coordinate sports and facilitate league competition among the campuses of the University of Maine System; and be it further

Sec. 3. Legislation. Resolved: That the Joint Standing Committee on Education and Cultural Affairs may report out a bill to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature pertaining to a coordinated sports program for the University of Maine System.'
