24	SUMMARY
26	This amendment substitutes the word "distiller" for

"manufacturer" to limit the scope of the bill and defines a "small distillery" to mean a distillery that does not produce spirits in excess of 50,000 gallons per year. It provides that a person may hold only one small distillery off-premises license and limits the renewal of the license to one additional year for distilleries that exceed the 50,000-gallon limit. It also exempts the holder of a small distillery off-premises license from being licensed as an agency store and clarifies that a person must hold a distiller license to be eligible for a small distillery off-premises license. This amendment clarifies that spirits sold on the distillery premises must go through the state

control system and requires that off-premises sales records be

kept separate from the distiller's other business records.

also clarifies that the license fee is \$100 annually.
