COMMITTEE AMENDMENT A to S.P. 463, L.D. 1336, Bill, "An Act To Promote Economic Development in Commercial and Downtown Areas of the State"

Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last line (page 2, line 3 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "locates"

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in subparagraph (1) in the first line (page 2, line 5 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "In" and inserting in its place the following: 'Locates in'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in subparagraph (2) in the first line (page 2, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "In" and inserting in its place the following: 'Is located in'

SUMMARY

This amendment clarifies that the prohibition on issuing liquor licenses to businesses located within 300 feet of a school or church does not apply to a school or church located in a downtown area.
