The-State-Tax-Assesser-shall-include-a-checkoff-to-request ax-application-fer A claimant may apply for a benefit under the Maine Residents Property Tax Program on the that claimant's individual income tax form. The assessor shall also provide for the option of filing an application for the Maine Residents Property Tax Program using the telefile system established by the assessor.
