SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 931, L.D. 1348, Bill, "An Act To Increase Funding for Meals on Wheels Program"

Amend the amendment by inserting after the title the following:

'Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the enacting clause the following:

**'Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

**Whereas,** the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

**Whereas,** certain obligations and expenses for the reimbursement of meals on wheels programs for travel expenses will become due and payable prior to June 30, 2006; and

**Whereas,** in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, ' '

Further amend the amendment in the first paragraph after the title in the first line (page 1, line 22 in amendment) by striking out the following: "Amend" and inserting in its place the following: 'Further amend'

inserting at the end a new sentence to read: 'Any unexpended

10 'Further amend the bill in section 1 by striking out all of  
the last 4 lines (page 1, lines 14 to 17 in L.D.) and inserting  
12 in their place the following:



and requires that any unexpended funds must be carried forward.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the FY 2005-06 appropriation by \$25,000 and eliminates the FY 2006-07 appropriation for supplemental funding for mileage reimbursement to volunteers of meals on wheels programs. The amendment adds an emergency preamble and language allowing the funds appropriated for FY 2005-06 to carry for use in subsequent fiscal years. The amount that would lapse to the General Fund without this amendment's carrying language cannot be estimated at this time.
