40 This amendment replaces the bill. The amendment specifies that the results of a point of collection substance abuse 42 screening test must be provided to the employee who is the subject of the test immediately, regardless of the preliminary 44 result. The amendment also states that the results of a point of collection screening test may not be released to the employer 46 until after results of a confirmation test have been determined or until after the time it would have taken for results of a 48 confirmation test to be determined if one had been performed. The amendment further specifies that the results of a confirmation

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test must be provided immediately to both the employee and employer.

Additionally, the amendment directs the Department of Labor to establish a task force on substance abuse testing and treatment and details the duties, membership and reporting obligations of the task force.
