Presented by Representative MARLEY of Portland. (GOVERNOR'S BILL) Cosponsored by Senator DAMON of Hancock. Emergency preamble. Whereas, acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, the 90-day period may not terminate until after the beginning of the next fiscal year; and

8 Whereas, certain obligations and expenses incident to the operation of state departments and institutions will become due 10 and payable immediately; and

12 Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of 14 Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and 16 safety; now, therefore,

18 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:

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PART A

22 Sec. A-1. Allocations. In order to provide for necessary expenditures of State Government and other purposes for the fiscal years ending June 30, 2006 and June 30, 2007, 24 the following Highway Fund allocations as designated in the following 26 tabulations are made. Other funds are presented for informational purposes only.
