Further amend the amendment in section 9 in the 5th line from the end (page 4, line 10 in amendment) by inserting after the following: "project financing." the following: 'The commission shall explore combining cell phone towers and similar structures with wind power generating equipment and structures.'

Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

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SUMMARY

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This amendment directs the Public Utilities Commission to study and report on the type of electricity generation referred to as "community wind." The commission is directed to provide a report of its findings and recommendations by January 13, 2006 and to submit legislation to provide a strategy to rapidly implement feasible community wind sites. This amendment also requires the Public Utilities Commission to explore combining cell phone towers and similar structures with wind power generating equipment and structures.
