Sec. 2. Report and recommendations. Resolved: That the Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Maine Revenue Services shall report its findings under section 1 and recommendations, including suggested legislation if appropriate, to the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters no later than February 14, 2007; and be it further

Sec. 3. Authority to report out legislation. Resolved: That the joint standing committee of the Legislature having jurisdiction over state and local government matters is authorized to report out legislation concerning the study under section 1 to the First Regular Session of the 123rd Legislature.'

SUMMARY

This amendment replaces the bill and is the minority report. The amendment is a resolve that directs Maine Revenue Services to establish a working group to examine options for reevaluating the distribution of property tax within municipalities and between service center and nonservice center municipalities. The working group must include members from the Maine Municipal Association, the Maine Service Centers Coalition, institutions of higher education in the State, the Maine Hospital Association, the YMCA, the Maine Council of Churches and other representatives of charitable or tax-exempt organizations.
