SUMMARY

26 This amendment changes the percentages, authorizing expenditures of up to 97.5% unless a sum equal to 2.5% of the projected revenues is held in the special reserve account. The amendment also requires the Legislature to place an annual 30 minimum percentage in the account until a minimum balance accrues. The amendment also clarifies borrowing authority and the question.
