Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation requires various products, fixtures and equipment to meet certain energy standards that have not been developed yet but are to be adopted by the Public Utilities Commission no later than January 1, 2006. The additional costs to the state from complying with the new energy standards can not be determined at this time. The costs associated with developing the standards will be absorbed by the Public Utilities Commission utilizing existing budgeted resources.
