2	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 30-A MRSA §4722, sub-§1, ¶X, as amended by PL 2003, c.
4	704, §5, is further amended to read:
6	X. Advise the Governor and other officials of State Government on matters relating to energy conservation; and
8	Sec. 2. 30.4 MDSA 84722 sub \$1. TV as supplied to Dr. 2002
10	Sec. 2. 30-A MRSA §4722, sub-§1, ¶Y, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 704, §6, is amended to read:
12	Y. Expand access to housing for young professionals and young families. The Maine State Housing Authority shall
14	develop recommendations to create or modify programs with the goal of expanding access to housing for young
16	professionals and young families. The Maine State Housing Authority shall specifically consider strategies to assist
18	renters and first-time home buyers who are under 35 years of age and explore options for linking assistance levels to
20	student loan obligations. The Maine State Housing Authority shall collaborate with the Maine Community College System,
22	vocational high schools and community action programs to encourage the development of affordable housing in high-cost
24	housing areas of the State.
26	(1) The Maine State Housing Authority shall report its findings and recommendations regarding expanded access
28	to housing for young professionals and young families to the Future for Youth in Maine State Work Action

42	withhold the funds of or suspend or revoke the funds already granted to a person or organization under this paragraph
44	after providing notice and hearing pursuant to Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 4.
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SUMMARY

This bill allows the Maine State Housing Authority after 4 notice and hearing to withhold the funds of or suspend or revoke the funds already granted to any person or organization who 6 violates any health, safety or sanitation standard of the Maine State Housing Authority or the municipality in which the subject 8 housing is located.

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
