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### SUMMARY

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10 This amendment sets the same standard for the Legislative  
Council to develop guidelines for incorporating Maine-grown  
12 products into events in the State House as is set for the Cross  
Cafe in the resolve. The amendment changes the daily Maine-made  
feature to a weekly Maine-made feature. It also requires the  
14 Department of Administrative and Financial Services and the  
manager of the Cross Cafe to develop mechanisms for Maine food  
16 producers to offer and distribute their products to the cafe.

### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The Legislative Council will absorb the additional costs associated with developing guidelines for incorporating more Maine-grown foods to be served by outside groups in the State House. The additional costs associated with developing a plan for incorporating more Maine-grown products at the Cross Cafe can be absorbed by the Department of Administrative and Financial Services. Any additional costs associated with assisting vendors with increased access to Maine-grown products can be absorbed by the Department of Agriculture and Rural Resources utilizing existing budgeted resources.
