HOUSE AMENDMENT "*A*" to H.P. 1027, L.D. 1464, Bill, "An Act
To Amend the Laws Relating to Motorized Scooters, Motor-driven
Cycles and Mopeds"

18

20 Amend the bill in section 16 by striking out all of
subsection 3 (page 4, lines 30 to 36 in L.D.) and inserting in
its place the following:

22

24 '**3. Motorized bicycle, tricycle or scooter operator.** A
motorized bicycle or tricycle or motorized scooter may only be
operated by a person who possesses a valid license of any class,
26 an instruction permit or a license endorsed for a motorcycle,
~~motor-driven-eyele~~ or moped. The Secretary of State may not
28 require the operator of a motorized bicycle or tricycle or
motorized scooter to obtain a license endorsed for a motorcycle,
30 ~~motor-driven-eyele~~ or moped.'

Further amend the bill in section 26 by striking out all of
paragraph B (page 7, lines 44 and 45 in L.D.) and inserting in
34 its place the following:

36

'B. Bicycles or other nonmotorized traffic, scooters,
motorized bicycles or tricycles, or ~~motor-driven-eyeles~~
38 motorized scooters.'

Further amend the bill in section 28 by striking out all of
subsection 1 (page 8, lines 5 to 9 in L.D.) and inserting in its
42 place the following:

R.O.S.

2 '1. Definitions. For the purpose of this section,
"bicycle" includes a motorized bicycle or, a motorized tricycle
4 ~~or a motorized scooter, "seeter"--includes--a--motorized--seeter~~
6 and "toy vehicle" includes, but is not limited to, skateboards,
rollerskates, wagons, sleds and coasters.'

8 Further amend the bill by striking out all of section 29
(page 8, lines 11 to 15 in L.D.)

10 Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any
12 nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read
14 consecutively.

16 SUMMARY


18 This amendment does the following.

20 The amendment requires the operator of a motorized scooter
to have a valid license of any class.

22 The amendment allows municipalities to prohibit the use of
24 motorized scooters on public ways.

26 The amendment requires motorized scooters to follow the same
rules of the road as bicycles.

28 The amendment maintains the current law that prohibits
30 motorized scooters from being operated at a speed in excess of 20
miles per hour.
