SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1027, L.D. 1464, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Relating to Motorized Scooters, Motor-driven Cycles and Mopeds"

Amend the amendment by inserting after section 30 the following:

'Further amend the bill in section 33 in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last line (page 9, line 10 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "test; and" and inserting in its place the following: 'test; and'


Further amend the bill in section 33 in subsection 1 in paragraph D in the first line (page 9, line 12 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "headgear." and inserting in its place the following: 'headgear; and'

Further amend the bill in section 33 in subsection 1 by inserting after paragraph D the following:

'E. An operator of a motorized scooter operating on a town way in accordance with section 2063-B.'

SUMMARY

This amendment requires that a person operating a motorized scooter on a town way wear protective headgear.
