SENATE AMENDMENT 'A' to H.P. 1027, L.D. 1464, Bill, "An Act To Amend the Laws Relating to Motorized Scooters, Motor-driven Cycles and Mopeds"

Amend the bill by inserting after section 29 the following:

'Sec. 30. 29-A MRSA §2063-B is enacted to read:


§2063-B. Operation of motorized scooters on town ways

A person may operate a motorized scooter on a town way, as described in Title 23, section 53, subsection 1, unless such operation is prohibited by a municipal ordinance.'

Further amend the bill by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.

SUMMARY

This amendment allows a person to operate a motorized scooter on a town way, unless such operation is prohibited by a municipal ordinance.
