The review must include information on 30 the methods of reimbursement used by private health insurance 32 carriers and Medicare and other publicly funded programs. department shall submit a report detailing the review required by 34 this section to the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services by January 15, 2006. The Joint Standing Committee on 36 Health and Human Services may report out legislation to make changes in how MaineCare reimburses health care providers to the Second Regular Session of the 122nd Legislature.' 38
