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COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " " to H.P. 1045, L.D. 1488, Bill, "An  
Act To Give Parents Control over the Sex Education of Their  
Children"

24 Amend the bill by inserting after the title and before the  
enacting clause the following:

26 'Mandate preamble. This measure requires one or more local  
28 units of government to expand or modify activities so as to  
necessitate additional expenditures from local revenues but does  
30 not provide funding for at least 90% of those expenditures.  
Pursuant to the Constitution of Maine, Article IX, Section 21,  
32 2/3 of all of the members elected to each House have determined  
it necessary to enact this measure.'

#### State Mandate

##### New or Expanded Activity

Requiring school administrative units to notify parents and guardians of the comprehensive family life education class, to provide information to parents or guardians of students on the content of the class and to obtain written consent before providing the class to the student is a mandate. The impact to individual school units can not be determined at this time. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.
