'Sec. 6. Appropriations and allocations. The following appropriations and allocations are made.

HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES, DEPARTMENT OF

Homestead Facility

Initiative: Provides an initial allocation for the Homestead Facility, Other Special Revenue Funds account for payments or income received from residents of the facility, the Medicaid program or other 3rd-party payments.

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

The bill may result in the collection of additional Other Special Revenue Funds revenue that would offset currently General Fund costs. The amount will depend on the number of residents at the facility with income to contribute, Medicaid or other 3rd party payor. Establishes an initial allocation of \$500 for the new Homestead Facility Other Special Revenue Funds account.
