## COMMITTEE AMENDMENT 'A" to H.P. 1050, L.D. 1493

Further amend the resolve in section 2 in the question in the last line (page 1, line 28 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "zone" the following: ', which is the same as year-round Eastern Daylight Saving Time'

#### **SUMMARY**

This amendment clarifies that if Maine moves to Atlantic 24 Standard Time there would be no recognition of daylight saving time and amends the referendum question to reflect this. The 26 referendum would be held at the same time as the November election in 2006. The amendment also states that the referendum 28 may go ahead only if the costs are raised privately.
