Fiscal Detail and Notes

This bill includes ongoing General Fund appropriations of \$50,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2005-06 to establish the nursing education loan repayment program to be administered by the Finance Authority of Maine. The Authority estimates the cost to administer the program to be approximately \$23,700 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$4,000 per year beginning in fiscal year 2006-07. Because this legislation provides for the Authority to utilize a portion of the funds appropriated in this bill for its administrative costs, no additional General Fund appropriations are required.
