36	SUMMARY
38	This bill changes the definition of "person" for purposes of the Maine Business Corporation Act to specify that "person" means
40	a natural person and not an entity such as a corporation, a state, the United States or a foreign government. The purpose of
42	this change is to prohibit a corporation from engaging in political speech or activity using funds of the corporation,
44	unless those funds are from a segregated account established specifically for the purpose of funding political speech or
46	activity.
