34 Further amend the resolve in section 4 in the 4th line (page
36 2, line 4 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "Executive
38 Director of the Legislative Council" and inserting in its place
40 the following: 'Secretariat of the Capitol Planning Commission'

42 Further amend the resolve in section 5 by striking out all
44 of subsection 1 (page 2, lines 16 and 17 in L.D.) and inserting
46 in its place the following:

48 '1. Where within the areas described in section 11 of this
resolve, the memorial should be located;'

Further amend the resolve by striking out all of section 6
and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the Department of
Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of General Services
shall provide necessary staffing services to the committee; and
be it further

Sec. 7. Meetings. Resolved: That the committee may hold up to
4 meetings, one of which must be a public hearing; and be it
further'

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 516, L.D. 1498

2 Further amend the resolve by striking out all of sections 8
to 12 and inserting in their place the following:

6 **Sec. 8. Funding. Resolved:** That the committee shall seek
outside funds to fully fund all costs of the committee. If
8 sufficient outside funding has not been received by November 15,
2005 to fully fund all costs of the committee, no meetings are
10 authorized and no expenses of any kind may be incurred or
reimbursed. Contributions to support the work of the committee
12 may not be accepted from any party having a pecuniary or other
vested interest in the outcome of the matters being studied. The
14 Department of Administrative and Financial Services shall
establish an account to receive donations and other funds raised
16 for the memorial. All funds accepted must be forwarded to the
department along with an accounting record that includes the
18 amount of funds, date the funds were received, from whom the
funds were received and the purpose and any limitation on the use
20 of the funds. The Department of Administrative and Financial
Services, Bureau of General Services shall administer any funds
22 received. The Department of Administrative and Financial
Services must transfer sufficient funds to the Legislature at the
24 beginning of the fiscal year for the payment of per diem and
expenses of the Legislators; and be it further

26 **Sec. 9. Consultation; reports. Resolved:** That, no later than
January 2, 2006, the committee shall submit its initial report
28 for review by the Capitol Planning Commission. A final report
must be submitted to the Capitol Planning Commission by March 1,
30 2006. Upon submission of its required reports, the committee
terminates; and be it further

34 **Sec. 10. Coordination with Capitol Planning Commission.**
Resolved: That, no later than January 15, 2006, the Capitol
Planning Commission shall submit its initial report to the Joint
36 Standing Committee on State and Local Government identifying
where, within the Capitol Planning District boundaries, it
38 intends to establish a memorial park. The initial report must
also include criteria for the types of memorials permitted, the
40 method for submission and the approval of a memorial and the
criteria for material, design and scale of proposed memorials.
42 The final report to the Joint Standing Committee on State and
Local Government is due on March 15, 2006. If a suitable
44 location for the emergency medical services memorial cannot be
located within the memorial park, then the memorial may be
46 located adjacent to the existing police and firefighters
memorials; and be it further

SUMMARY

12 This amendment requires the Committee to Study the
Establishment of a Memorial for Emergency Medical Services
14 Personnel to coordinate with the Capitol Planning Commission
rather than the Legislative Council. It also requires the
Department of Administrative and Financial Services, Bureau of
16 General Services to provide staff assistance rather than the
Office of Policy and Legal Analysis. The amendment requires the
18 committee, if outside funding is received, to hold up to 4
meetings, one of which must be a public hearing. The committee
20 must submit its initial report to the Capitol Planning Commission
by January 2, 2006 and the final report by March 1, 2006. The
22 Capitol Planning Commission must submit its initial report to the
Committee on State and Local Government by January 15, 2006 and
24 its final report by March 15, 2006.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

This legislation includes an Other Special Revenue allocation to the Department of Administrative and Financial Services of \$2,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 to provide funds for the expenses of members of the Committee to Study the Establishment of a Memorial for Emergency Medical Services Personnel. This legislation also includes an Other Special Revenue Funds allocation to the Legislature of \$1,260 in fiscal year 2005-06 to provide funds for the per diem and expenses of two legislative members of the committee. These allocations are required in the event outside funding is collected to support the activities of the committee.

This legislation states that if sufficient outside funding is not received to fully fund all costs of the committee, no meetings are authorized and no expenses of any kind may be incurred or reimbursed. Also, the Department of Administrative and Financial Services must transfer sufficient funds to the Legislature at the beginning of the fiscal year for the payment of per diem and expenses of the legislators.
