HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1058, L.D. 1513, Bill, "An Act To Require Coordinated Early Childhood Care and Preschool Education in Maine"

Amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4255.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph B in the 2nd line (page 1, line 51 in amendment) by striking out the following: "and"

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4255.~~" in subsection 1 in paragraph C in the last line (page 2, line 4 in amendment) by striking out the following: "." and inserting in its place the following: '; and'

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~§4255.~~" in subsection 1 by inserting after paragraph C the following:

'D. Demonstrated adherence by the school administrative unit to policies set forth in the Department of Health and Human Services child care licensing guidelines for care of children with respect to safety issues and adult-to-child ratios.'
