0	This bill is a concept draft pursuant to Joint Rule 208.
8	This bill proposes to provide reimbursement for road
10	maintenance to property owners in the unorganized territory. To
	be eligible for reimbursement, a property owner must be a member
12	of an organized road association that has a road maintenance plan, that maintains at least 4 miles of road and that permits
14	year-round recreational access to the public over roads
	maintained by the association, including access to boat launches
16	and snowmobile trails. This reimbursement would be at a per mile
	rate and based upon how many miles of road an association
18	maintains. A portion of the property taxes paid by these property owners would be used to provide this reimbursement.
