2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 10 MRSA §1150** is enacted to read:

6 **§1150. Receipt required for credit card and debit card**
8 **gasoline sales**

10 A person, firm, partnership, association, corporation or
12 limited liability company that accepts a credit card or debit
14 card for the retail purchase of gasoline shall provide to the
16 purchaser at the gasoline pump a receipt that includes the total
18 number of gallons purchased and the price per gallon.
