	SUMMARY

	This bill amends the law authorizing the medical use of
18	marijuana in the following ways.
20	 It increases the amounts considered a useable amount for
	medical use. It also authorizes a physician to indicate a
22	greater amount if necessary to meet the medical needs of the
	patient or to accommodate the various means of administering
24	marijuana.
26	It requires the Department of Health and Human Services
	to issue identification cards to an eligible patient or that
28	person's designated caregiver so that a person's lawful
	possession may be easily and expeditiously verified.

	3. This bill also clearly articulates that the fact that a
32	parent was or is a user of marijuana under the medical exemption
	may not be used against that parent in any matter relating to the
34	care and custody of a child.
