#### State Mandate

#### New or Expanded Activity

Administrative activity associated with the calculation of the exemption amount for cooperative housing corporation property is a state mandate. Pursuant to the Mandate Preamble, the two-thirds vote of all members elected to each House exempts the State from the constitutional requirement to fund 90% of the additional local costs.

## Unit Affected Costs

Municipality Insignificant

#### Fiscal Detail and Notes

This amendment reduces the General Fund cost of Committee "A" by \$290,000 in fiscal year 2006-07. The revised estimate of the additional cost to reimburse municipalities for 50% of the revenue loss associated with the increase in exempt property is now projected to be \$250,000 annually, beginning in fiscal year 2007-08 based on an April 1, 2007 application date.
