	Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
2	Sec. 1. 36 MRSA §1760, sub-§88 is enacted to read:

	88. Certain sales by incorporated nonprofit organizations
6	that administer creative problem-solving competitions. Sales to
8	and by incorporated nonprofit membership-based organizations that administer creative problem-solving competitions and are part of
10	national and international competitions for the benefit of students from kindergarten through college. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1754-B, subsections 2-B and 2-C,
12	organizations that qualify for this exemption are entitled to
14	receive a resale certificate from the State Tax Assessor. Sec. 2. Application. That section of this Act that enacts the
16	Maine Revised Statutes, Title 36, section 1760, subsection 88
-•	applies to sales occurring on or after October 1, 2005.
