COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 542, L.D. 1558, Bill, "An Act Concerning Storm Water Management"

Amend the bill in section 7 in subsection 13 in paragraph D in subparagraph (3) in the first line (page 4, line 4 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "A municipal" the following: 'storm water'

This amendment clarifies that certain municipal storm water conveyance systems are excluded from the definition of "significant existing source."

The net effect of the proposed changes in the storm water fee structure will result in an increase in dedicated revenue to the Maine Environmental Protection Fund of approximately \$5,500 annually. The additional costs related to the storm water management changes can be absorbed by the Department of Environmental Protection utilizing existing budgeted resources.
