4 **Sec. 1. 20-A MRSA §6104** is enacted to read:

6 **§6104. Legislative review**

8 Notwithstanding section 6101, subsection 2, paragraph B, the
10 Department of Education shall release to the Legislature
12 aggregate information concerning the law requiring fingerprinting
14 and background checks of educational personnel in order to
16 measure the effectiveness of the law.
