HOUSE AMENDMENT "D" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 555,
L.D. 1577, Bill, "An Act To Modify the Calculation and Implementation Date of Savings Offset Payments under the Dirigo
Health Act"

20 Amend the amendment in Part A in section 11 in subsection 2 in paragraph D in the last line (page 5, line 43 in amendment) by 22 inserting after the following: "Forum." the following: 'Pursuant to section 6912, the cost of any experience modification program 24 or similar arrangement must be considered a general administrative expense.'

Further amend the amendment in Part C in section 8 in that 28 part designated "**§6910.**" in subsection 4 in paragraph A by striking out all of subparagraphs (6) and (7) (page 15, lines 30 30 to 44 in amendment) and inserting in their place the following:

32 '(6) Dirigo Health may administer continuation benefits for eligible individuals from employers with 34 20 or more employees who have purchased health insurance coverage through Dirigo Health for the 36 duration of their eligibility periods for continuation benefits pursuant to the federal Consolidated Omnibus 38 Budget Reconciliation Act, Public Law 99-272, Title X, Private Health Insurance Coverage, Sections 10001 to 40 10003; and

42 (7) Dirigo Health may administer or contract to administer the United States Internal Revenue Code of
44 1986, Section 125 plans for employers and employees participating in Dirigo Health, including medical
46 expense reimbursement accounts and dependent care reimbursement accounts.



## **Fiscal Note**

### **Fiscal Detail and Notes**

Assumes the exclusion of experience modification program costs from the savings offset amount calculation could reduce savings offset payment revenue below amounts assumed for the Dirigo Health program's 2006-2007 Part 1 Current Services budget baseline. Assumes the elimination of an experience modification program after December 31, 2006 could result in a short-term reduction in spending, but the longer term implications are not known at this time.
