22	Amend the bill in section 1 in subsection 2 by striking out
24	all of the blocked paragraph (page 1, lines 16 to 20 in L.D.) and inserting in its place the following:
26	' <u>A candidate, a candidate's spouse or a surrogate of the</u> candidate may not orally communicate in a repetitive or
28	systematic way within 100 feet of the voting place with voters entering the voting place. These The limitations in this
30	subsection do not prohibit a candidate from attending the voting place and erally-communicating-with-veters voting or inspecting
32	the polls as long as the candidate does not attempt to influence their the vote of others. A candidate may not state the name of
34	the office sought or request a person's vote.'
