Legislative Study

The projected general operating expenses of the Commission to Evaluate the Criteria for Siting Agency Liquor Stores are \$6,210 in fiscal year 2005-06. The Legislature's budget includes \$30,000 in fiscal year 2005-06 and \$20,000 in fiscal year 2006-07 for legislative studies. Whether the amounts are sufficient to fund all studies will depend on the number of studies authorized by the Legislative Council and the Legislature.

Fiscal Detail and Notes

The additional costs associated with participating as members of the commission can be absorbed by the Department of Public Safety and the Department of Health and Human Services utilizing existing budgeted resources.
