## Resolve, To Establish a Commission To Evaluate Criteria for Siting Agency Liquor Stores

(AFTER DEADLINE)

Approved for introduction by a majority of the Legislative Council pursuant to Joint Rule 205.

Reference to the Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs suggested and ordered printed.

Presented by Senator GAGNON of Kennebec. Cosponsored by Representative PATRICK of Rumford. **Emergency preamble. Whereas,** acts and resolves of the 2 Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

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Whereas, this resolve creates the Commission to Evaluate the Criteria for Siting Agency Liquor Stores; and

8 Whereas, the study must be initiated before the 90-day period expires in order that the study may be completed and a 10 report submitted in time for submission to the next legislative session; and

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Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Sec. 1. Commission established. Resolved: That the Commission to Evaluate the Criteria for Siting Agency Liquor Stores, referred to in this resolve as "the commission," is established; and be it further

Sec. 2. Commission membership. Resolved: That the commission consists of 10 members appointed as follows:

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 Three members of the Senate appointed by the President
of the Senate. One member must serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and Financial Affairs, one member
must serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs and one member must serve on the Joint Standing Committee
on Health and Human Services;

 Five members of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker of the House. Two members must serve on the Joint
Standing Committee on Legal and Veterans Affairs, 2 members must serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Appropriations and
Financial Affairs and one member must serve on the Joint Standing Committee on Health and Human Services;

The Commissioner of Public Safety or the commissioner's
designee; and

44 4. The Commissioner of Health and Human Services or the commissioner's designee; and be it further

Sec. 3. Chairs. Resolved: That the first-named Senate member is the Senate chair of the commission and the first-named House of Representatives member is the House chair of the commission; and be it further

Sec. 4. Appointments; convening of commission. Resolved: 2 That all appointments must be made no later than 30 days following the effective date of this resolve. The appointing authorities shall 4 notify the Executive Director of the Legislative Council once all appointments have been completed. Within 15 days 6 after appointment of all members, the chairs shall call and convene the 8 first meeting of the commission, which must be no later than August 1, 2005; and be it further

Sec. 5. Duties. Resolved: That the commission shall hold meetings at various locations in the State, to be determined by the chairs. The commission shall:

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1. Evaluate the criteria for siting agency liquor stores;

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2. Invite the participation of interested parties;

 Identify and recommend appropriate actions the State may
take to establish the criteria for siting agency liquor stores; and
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Identify and discuss other issues relevant to this
study; and be it further

26 Sec. 6. Staff assistance. Resolved: That the Legislative Council shall provide necessary staffing services to the commission; and 28 be it further

Sec. 7. Compensation. Resolved: That the legislative members 30 of the commission are entitled to receive the legislative per diem, as defined in the Maine Revised Statutes, Title 3, section 32 2, and reimbursement for travel and other necessary expenses related to their attendance at authorized meetings of the 34 Public members not otherwise compensated by their commission. 36 employers or other entities that they represent are entitled to receive reimbursement of necessary expenses and, upon а demonstration of financial hardship, a per diem equal to the 38 legislative per diem for their attendance at authorized meetings of the commission; and be it further 40

42 Sec. 8. Report. Resolved: That, no later than November 4, 2005, the commission shall submit a report that includes its 44 findings and recommendations, including suggested legislation, for presentation to the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and 46 Veterans Affairs and the Legislative Council. The commission is not authorized to introduce legislation. Following receipt and 48 review of the report, the Joint Standing Committee on Legal and 48 Veterans Affairs may report out a bill to the Second Regular 50 Session of the 122nd Legislature; and be it further 2 Sec. 9. Extension. Resolved: That, if the commission requires a limited extension of time to complete its study and make its 4 report, it may apply to the Legislative Council, which may grant an extension; and be it further

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Sec. 10. Commission budget. Resolved: That the chairs of the commission, with assistance from the commission staff, shall 8 administer the commission's budget. Within 10 days after its first meeting, the commission shall present a work plan and 10 proposed budget to the Legislative Council for its approval. The commission may not incur expenses that would result in the 12 commission's exceeding its approved budget. Upon request from 14 the commission, the Executive Director of the Legislative Council shall promptly provide the commission chairs and staff with a status report on the commission budget, expenditures incurred and 16 paid and available funds.

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve takes effect when approved.

## **SUMMARY**

This resolve establishes the Commission to Evaluate the 26 Criteria for Siting Agency Liquor Stores.
