2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:**

4 **Sec. 1. 21-A MRSA §122, sub-§10** is enacted to read:

6 10. Voter registration file. Within 5 days after receipt
8 of a voter registration application, the registrar shall place
10 the voter registration application in the voter registration file
12 pursuant to section 172.

14 **SUMMARY**

16 This bill requires a registrar of voters to place a voter registration application in the voter registration file within 5 days after receipt of the voter registration application.
