SENATE AMENDMENT "**B**" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 584, L.D. 1603, Bill, "An Act To Establish Harbor Master Standards and Training Requirements"

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the mandate preamble (page 1, lines 26 to 32 in amendment)

Further amend the amendment in section 1 in that part designated "~~S1-A.~~" in the first paragraph by inserting after the first sentence the following: 'The person serving as a harbor master or deputy harbor master shall pay the cost of the training.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting after section 1 the following:

'**Sec. 2. Application.** This Act applies to harbor masters or deputy harbor masters appointed after the effective date of this Act.'

SUMMARY

This amendment provides that the training required of a harbor master and deputy harbor master be paid for by the harbor
