Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine as follows:
Sec. 1. PL 2005, c. 2, Pt. F, §5 is amended to read:
Sec. F-5. Application. This Part applies retreastively to
property tax valuations determined on or after April 1, 2005 2006.
Sec. 2. Retroactivity. This Act applies retroactively to June 29, 2005.
SUMMARY
Legislative Document 1, "An Act To Increase the State Share
of Education Costs, Reduce Property Taxes and Reduce Government Spending at All Levels," which was signed into law as Public Law
2005, chapter 2, increased the Maine resident homestead property tax exemption amount to \$13,000 per permanent homestead.
beginning with property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2005.
This bill delays the exemption amount increase for one year,
to property tax years beginning on or after April 1, 2006.
