SENATE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1145, L.D. 1622, Bill, "An Act To Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Laws of Maine"

Amend the amendment by inserting after Part D the following:

PART E

Sec. E-1. 10 MRSA §11, sub-§8, as enacted by PL 2003, c. 699, §2, is further amended to read:

8. Staff. The Office of Policy and Legal Analysis shall provide the necessary staff support for the operation of the commission. The Legislative Council may curtail that staffing when the Legislature is in regular or special session. After one year, the commission shall assess the need for and qualifications of a staff person, for example, an executive director. If the commission determines that it requires such a person, it may request additional funds from the Legislature.'


Further amend the amendment by relettering or renumbering any nonconsecutive Part letter or section number to read consecutively.
