COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1633, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit the Disposal of Dangerous and Unsafe Material in Solid Waste Facilities"

Amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1316-O." in subsection 1 in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 33 and 34 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "might present a dangerous or unsafe situation" and inserting in its place the following: 'is capable of or likely to cause injury'

Further amend the bill in section 1 in that part designated "§1316-P." in the first paragraph in the 2nd and 3rd lines (page 1, lines 45 and 46 in L.D.) by striking out the following: "has been so identified or knows may be" and inserting in its place the following: 'is'

Further amend the bill in section 2 in the last line (page 2, line 13 in L.D.) by inserting after the following: "baggage." the following: 'Rules adopted pursuant to this section are routine technical rules as defined in Title 5, chapter 375, subchapter 2-A.'
