COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 1151, L.D. 1633, Bill, "An Act To Prohibit the Disposal of Dangerous and Unsafe Material in Solid Waste Facilities"

Amend the bill by striking out the title and substituting the following:

'Resolve, Regarding the Disposal of Propane Tanks and Other Dangerous Material'

Further amend the bill by striking out everything after the title and before the summary and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. Education regarding disposal of propane tanks. Resolved: That the Department of Environmental Protection shall develop an educational outreach effort for the purpose of educating the public on the proper disposal of propane tanks and other dangerous materials, including, but not limited to flammable liquids or solids and explosive materials such as dynamite or fireworks. The educational outreach effort must include the updating of any lists prepared by the department that provide information to the public regarding where propane tanks can be returned.'

This amendment is the minority report. The amendment directs the Department of Environmental Protection to develop an educational outreach effort for the purpose of educating the
